



TEACH CHILDREN TO SAVE

Twenty years ago, a nationwide educational initiative was launched to introduce the importance of saving money to children by the American Banker's Association. This concept leads to a healthier financial future for today's young people. The long-term financial well-being of our community has always been a priority for Somerset Trust Company and we are excited to have been a part of this program for nineteen years.

On Friday, April 20, 2018, elementary, middle, and high school students across America will participate in National Teach Children to Save Day to gain a better understanding of their financial needs. Last year a group of 12 employees visited 16 schools reaching over 1000 children.

Lesson plans are flexible and can cover a variety of topics. Our in-house education coordinator works with local school teachers to craft lesson plans that are relevant to students. Discussion topics may include what is a bank, coin recognition, counting money, smart saving strategies and financial planning. Lessons are supplemented with workbooks, educational videos, storybooks and interactive activities. These presentations enhance current school curriculum and benefit the students of our local schools with useful banking information.

Arrive: MAPS Museum- North Canton Ohio 1:00-2:30 PM

Your day begins with a visit to the MAPS Museum, one of the most unique Military History Museums in the country. Meet the men who flew the missions and who also work to restore the aircraft that are displayed. These volunteers have restored more than three dozen vintage airplanes, among them a 1909 glider, a B28 World War II bomber and several modern jet fighters. Exhibits include tributes to the Tuskegee Airmen, USS Arizona, WASPs, WWII and WWI aviators, and more.

Arrive: Warther Museum- Dover, Ohio 3:15-5:15 PM

At your next stop you will view awesome steam engine carvings by World Master Carver, Mooney Warther. The display features his most famous replica, the Lincoln Funeral Train. These gorgeous ebony, ivory and walnut carvings have been appraised as priceless by the Smithsonian. You will also have the chance to stroll through the Swiss Gardens to view Mrs. Warther's Button House (with over 70,000 buttons arranged into artwork), see the family home and visit the Knife Shop where Mooney made kitchen cutlery and commando knives for troops during WWII.

Arrive: Comfort Suites Banquet Center- Berlin, Ohio 5:45-8 PM

For your final stop you will board the bus and head to the Comfort Suites Banquet Center where you will be treated to a dinner performance by the Victory Canteen Singers, a group who will entertain you with the nostalgic sounds of the Forties. This music is reminiscent to the sounds that brought hope and joy to our GIs and those on the home front alike. The Victory Canteen Singers keep that tradition alive in rich three part harmony. Their repertoire includes WWII era classics as well as a musical salute to each branch of the US armed forces.

Completing the course enables drivers 55 and older who have a safe driving record to be eligible for a 5% discount on their automobile insurance premium. There are no tests of any kind, and Somerset Trust Company pays the registration fee for our customers. The course is an eight-hour refresher divided over two days. Participants must attend both days to be eligible for the discount.
